Dear parents,

Re: restrictions on the return of students to school following international travel

Following our most recent review of the ongoing threat of coronavirus, the following additional restrictions on pupils returning to school are in place from today.

- Pupils who return from international trips **must not come into school for a period of 14 days following their return to Nigeria.**
- Pupils who have come into close contact with someone who has travelled internationally **must also remain out of school for 14 days.**
- The school's medical team must be notified that a student will be self-isolating.
- An electronic self-isolation form should be completed and returned to school.
- Following this notification work will be provided to support the student's home study.
- Should textbooks and workbooks be required to help with home study please do not come to school to collect them. Arrangements can be made by phone for collections of books from the front gate.
- The pupil must meet with the medical team before returning to class.

Please carefully consider any plans for international travel during the Easter break. In particular, students taking public examinations in the summer term are advised against international travel. The 14-day self-isolation period will prevent them from taking any examination scheduled for the first two weeks after Easter.

The risk of contracting coronavirus in Nigeria remains thankfully low. However, the risk in many other parts of the world is much greater and it is very important that as a community we take all reasonable steps to reduce the risk to our pupils.
