Dates for Physical Resumption

Saturday 11th September 2001 Resumption for new boarders (all to resume by 1pm) Sunday 12th September 2001 Resumption for returning boarders (all to resume by 4pm)

Monday 13th September 2001 Physical lessons resume (all students on campus by 7.45am)

Requirements for Physical Resumption

To ensure that all students and staff are safe, it is a requirement that ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO RESUME TO SCHOOL WITH A NEGATIVE PCR TEST RESULT WITHIN 72 HOURS OF RESUMING. A COPY OF THE RESULT WILL BE REQUIRED ON DAY OF RESUMPTION.

We also request that any student returning from outside of Nigeria, self-isolate for one week at home in accordance with the Federal Government requirements, before returning to school with a negative PCR test result.

Procedure on Day of Resumption

Students will resume to school in the normal fashion, temperature checks will take place and students will go through the sanitation tunnels, a member of staff will collect a copy of the PCR test results. Wearing of Face Mask is compulsory. We request that only students alight from their vehicles, to reduce the risk to the BIS community.

We also remind parents that students are not permitted to bring mobile phones to school, if a student is found to have one, it will be confiscated and will not be returned until the end of term.

Dress Code

Students are expected to return to school in full school uniform with polished shoes. No student should return with unnatural hair colour or any form of attachment. All male students should be clean shaven, no form of beard is permitted. We thank you once again for partnering with us, as we work together to ensure all our students are safe and well and also to ensure that they have an excellent learning experience.
