Dubai World Games 2022

We are delighted to announce that we intend to send teams to represent BIS at the Dubai World Games from the 26th to 29th February 2022. Please see information below.

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you that we will be attending the Dubai World school Games next year. We intend to enter the competition with two teams U13 of 28 (U13 14 boys and 14 girls) and U15 of 28 (U15 14 boys and 14 girls) competitors. The U13 World School Games is open to students registered in Year 7 or Year 8 - only students born between **1st September 2007 and 31 August 2009** may be entered into the School Team while the U15 World School Games is open to students is open to students registered in Year 9 or Year 10 -

only students born between **1st September 2005 and 31 August 2007** may be entered into the School Team.

It is therefore my pleasure to invite your son/daughter to join us in our team selection trials which will take place on the following dates:

2nd November 2021 (football) 2:45pm – 3:45pm 3rd November 2021 (athletics) 2:45pm – 3:45pm

4th November 2021 (swimming) 2:45pm – 3:45pm

Students will be selected based on merits. Your child must have demonstrated the skills and athleticism necessary to be able to compete at this competition and must be good in at least two of the following sports (Football, Swimming and Athletics). There will be an A TEAM and B TEAM. If any student for any reason cannot make it for the trip a B TEAM student will be used as replacement. Each child will be ranked at the end of their weekly performance. If a child on the A TEAM misses training twice that child automatically goes to the B TEAM and is immediately replaced by a B TEAM member.

Once your child has been selected to be on the team. Further information will be sent to parents of the selected students on the training itinerary.

NOTE: Discipline, attendance, punctuality, and behaviour for the students determine if they will make it on the team or be removed from the team. Selected students will be published on 5th November 2021. Please note that once your child has missed trials another chance will not be given.
